#### **How do I register?**

Register online at www.fhyaa.com. Tentative registration window will be August 1st-September 15<sup>th</sup>. Once a division is at capacity, we will have to close registration.

### Where are practices and games held?

At 66-01 Fleet Street, Forest Hills, NY 11375.

### How often are games and when are they played?

2 games per week for all divisions. Games can be on weekends and weekdays. Double-headers are likely. Games are two 22 minute halves with a 5 minute halftime.

### Can I make teammate or coach requests?

All divisions are drafts, so no requests taken.

### How often are practices and when are they held?

Practices vary by team, but are usually once a week, per the coaches' availability and at their discretion. This will be communicated to families once teams are finalized.

### What equipment does my child need to play?

Mouth guards are mandatory. Cleats should be worn. Players will receive jerseys and belts with flags. We recommend football gloves. Games will be outside so dress appropriately for the cold weather.

#### When will I find out what team my child is on? When will I receive a game schedule?

Teams and schedules will be sent late October before the season starts. You can access team rosters and schedules in the TeamSnap app. If you haven't heard from your coach by that time, please email jenfrankel13@gmail.com

The registration fee is \$325 per player for the 2025 season.







## What if my child decides they don't want to play after we sign up?

We will try to accommodate a refund if the request is made **before the season starts**, but refunds are reviewed on a case by case basis.

#### What is the weather policy?

We strive to play as many games as possible, but will suspend or cancel games in inclement weather. You will be notified via email, TeamSnap, via coaches communications, on the FHYAA website/social. If you are not notified, please assume the game is on.

#### Will my child play in games?

Yes, FHYAA is an inclusive community league committed to delivering the positive benefits of team sports for all children. All players will play at least 50% of a game.

#### How can I sponsor a team?

#### How are teams created?

For all divisions, mandatory evaluations will take place in late September/early October at 66-01 Fleet St, Forest Hills. Then a draft takes place in October. Coaches draft players based on the information coaches received during evaluations.
